

## **Character Shield Directions**

- 1. Draw a shield similar to the example on a piece of notebook paper; this will be your **ROUGH DRAFT**.
- 2. In the top left hand corner, draw three pictures that symbolize important events in your life.
- 3. In the upper right hand corner, draw a symbol of somewhere you have lived or where you are living now.
- 4. In the lower right hand corner, put a quote that describes you or is one of your favorites.
- 5. In the lower left hand corner, put a symbol that describes what you are really like on the inside or something that no one knows about you.
- 6. In the center of the shield, draw an object that BEST identifies you (phone, shoe, pickup, ring, TV, book, etc.) and your personality type.
- 7. Transfer your <u>ROUGH DRAFT</u> onto a piece of <u>TYPING PAPER</u> or <u>POSTER BOARD</u>.
- 8. These shields can be hand drawn, in collage form using magazines or done using a computer. Be PROACTIVE

and do the best you can and just like in life everything will work out great ©.
